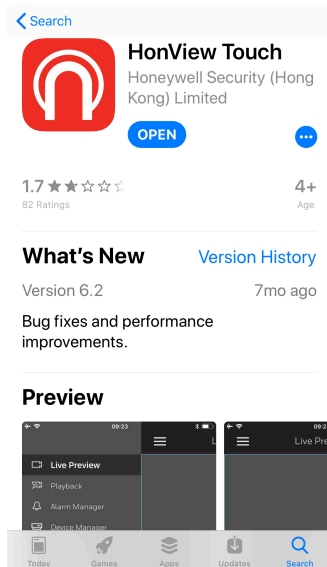


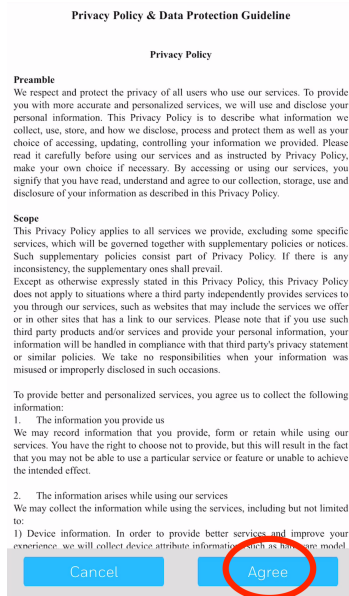


1. Download the HonView Touch App

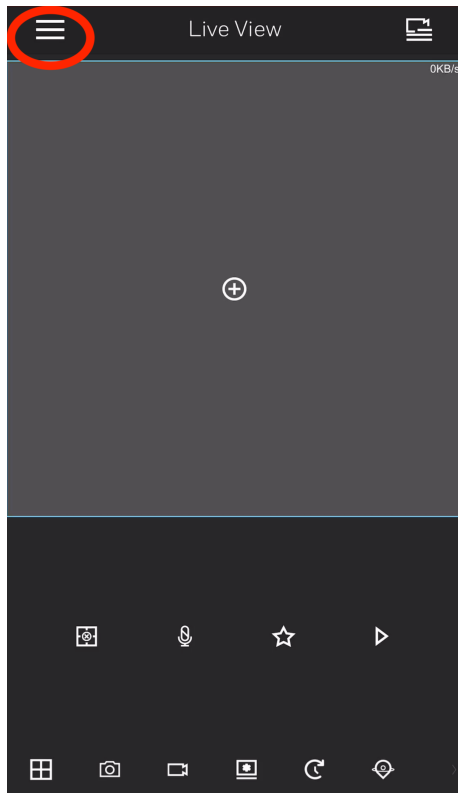


2. Open the app and allow access to photos

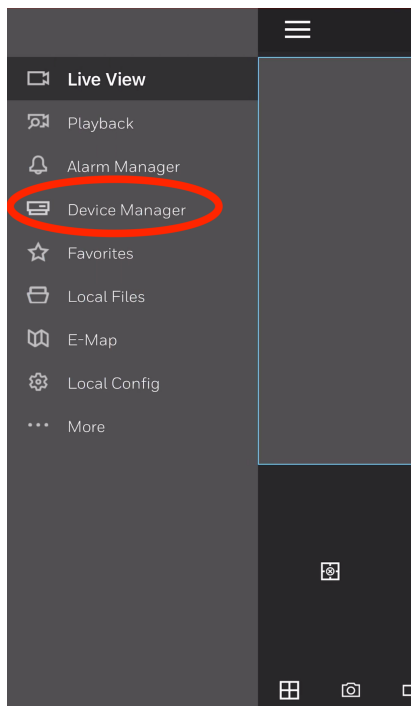
3. Read and Agree to Privacy Policy



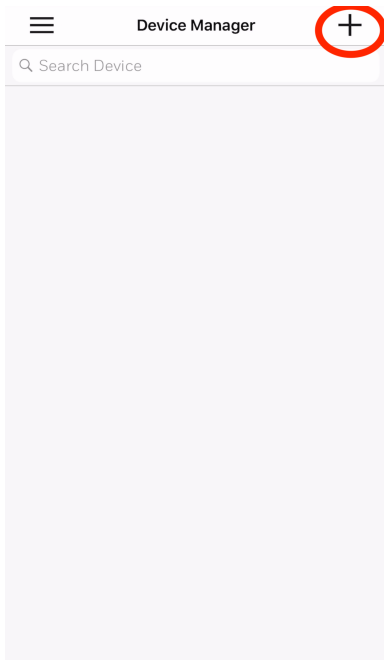
4. Tap the 3 lines in top left corner of screen



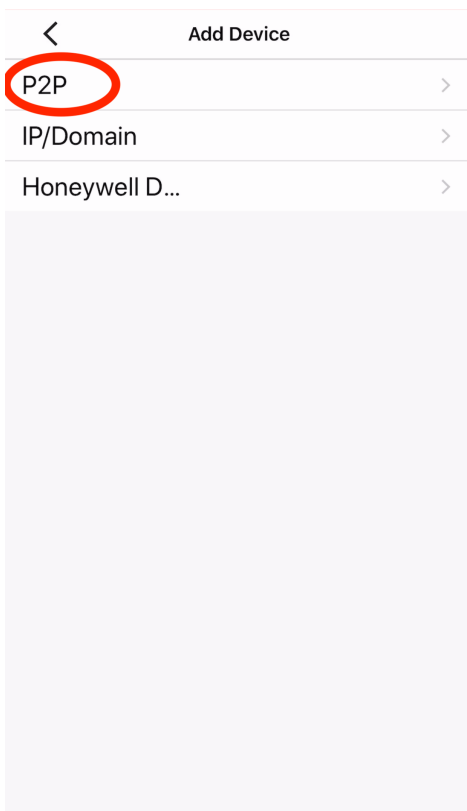
5. Tap "Device Manager"
