

Hurricane Season Pup Protection Checklist


Recently, we discussed the steps you can take to protect your pup when a storm is looming. Of course, the stress involved in preparing for a potential disaster can be a bit overwhelming, so here's a handy checklist that you can print out ahead of time to ensure that you've taken all necessary precautions.

Documents

- Photocopies of all vet records, including:
 - Rabies certificates
 - Complete list of current vaccinations
 - A summary of your dog's medical history
 - Prescriptions for all medications
 - Your pup's most recent heartworm test result
- Microchip information, including chip number, plus the microchip company's name and phone number
- Your contact information (including names, phone numbers, and addresses for any friends or family with whom you might be staying)
- Proof of ownership or adoption records
- Your dog's description, including breed, gender, color, and weight
- Recent photographs of each dog
- A waterproof container in which to store the documents

Water, Food, and Medication(s)

- A two-week supply of food for each dog, stored in waterproof containers
- A two-week supply of water for each dog
- A two-week supply of any medications
- Non-spilling food and water dishes
- A manual can opener
- Feeding instructions for each dog
- Medication instructions for each dog
- A one-month supply of the dog's flea, tick, and heartworm preventative treatment

Miscellaneous Other Supplies

- A leash, harness, and collar with an ID tag attached
- Favorite toys
- An appropriately sized pet carrier
- Blankets, bedding, or towels
- A pet first aid guide and kit
- Cleaning supplies for any accidents, including paper towels, plastic bags, and disinfectant

We sincerely hope you'll never need to follow an evacuation plan, but taking a little time to follow this checklist and be prepared is a wise choice.
